Thence by same ($N 6^{\circ} W$ 8.9 per.) to a stone corner; ($N 89^{\circ} W$ 75.2 per.) to a stone by a Rock Oak.

Thence by land of Thos. A & Matilda Warner - ^{far} stone ($S 6 \frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W$ 151.2 per.) to a stone corner in line of Henry Ecroyd; $S 82^{\circ} E$ 118.0 per.) to a stone in the road.

The place of beginning being the corner of W.S. Mendenhall and lot of heirs of John Neese.

On line of J. McCon. Containing 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres and 63 per.

Whereas, the above describes piece of parcel of a larger tract which John C. & Eliya Carpenter by their Deed, duly executed bearing date May 10, 1811 and recorded in \rightarrow on April 12, 1813 did grant the same unto Samuel Simpson (will Oct. 3, 1832) gave unto his friends John Warner and Yousse ^{Akison Simpson} ~~Warner~~ his wife.
